 - Visit a driver license site and provide the out-of-state license, proof of legal name and date of birth (e.g. birth certificate, passport, marriage certificate)
 - Required to pass a vision test, and possible written or road tests
 - Update vehicle insurance to ensure coverage in ND; www.nd.gov/ndins


